Overview: Boys & Girls Club of Assabet Valley Counselor In Training (CIT) Program is designed for those campers who turn 13 by July 1, 2010, and who are interested in becoming better leaders. This program covers an intense curriculum that includes such topics as leadership, conflict resolution, child development and group dynamics that leads to the making of a successful Boys & Girls Club of Assabet Valley Employee, and a better leader. CITs attend weekly sessions, get their certification in CPR & First Aid and will be evaluated by the Camp Staff at the end of their session. Successful completion of the program and positive evaluations could lead to the participant being invited back the following season as an intern or potentially a paid staff member. Because of the small number of spaces available and the highly competitive nature of this program, all potential applicants must complete the following application in order to determine suitability for the program. Applications will be reviewed and accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis, and all accepted participants will be notified of the application being received.
